

Using your template in eBay's SYI (Sell Your Item) form

- Open your template with Notepad. (Do NOT use Word or WordPad – HTML must be edited with a plain text program, such as Notepad.)
- Save this file with a name which will identify the item for which you are using the template, such as widget123.txt.
- You will first edit the title & description of this file to add the specific info about the item (widget123, in this sample).
